Regulations of the sport auto-DriftChallenge 2009

- 1) The registration for the sport auto-DriftChallenge 2009 is carried out with the enclosed entry form and is binding. The entry fee of € 150 (incl. German VAT at 19%) has to be deposited in due time into the bank account mentioned in the cover letter. When registering, please state the keyword „DriftChallenge“ as well as the event location and date. After the closing date, there will be an additional entry fee of € 50, whereas participation cannot be guaranteed.
- 2) The participating drivers must hold a valid driving licence and are obliged to present it upon registration at the Race Office. Furthermore, the organisers can inspect the driving licence at any time.
- 3) It is absolutely mandatory to wear a helmet. All racing or motorbike helmets complying with the current safety regulations are allowed.
- 4) On site the organiser will give out sponsoring stickers that are mandatory advertising and that have to be placed on the designated areas of the registered car. When registering at the Race Office, all participants will receive directions on where to apply the stickers.
- 5) A maximum of two participants can register and drive one and the same car. The cars must possess towing hooks which have to be marked with a 10 cm long red, yellow or white arrow (in contrast to the colour of the vehicle).
- 6) The cars have to comply with the noise control directives required on the racetrack (max. 95 dB). They have to be covered by a liability insurance but do not need to be road-legal at all costs.
- 7) The number of participants is limited to a total of 60. The editorial department reserves its right to decline registrations without giving reasons.

Cancellation of the Event

The organiser reserves his right to cancel the event up to seven days prior to the beginning due to force majeure or an impending commercial damage. Claims against the organiser cannot be asserted.

The undersigned acknowledges the conditions of participation, including the liability renunciation as binding. sport auto has the right to postpone or cancel the event due to important reasons. Only drivers with a valid licence for driving private cars are permitted to participate at the sport auto-DriftChallenge 2009. The undersigned is obliged to allow his licence to be inspected.

Undersigned, whose vehicle is not road-legal, have to take out a third party insurance for personal injury, property damage and economic loss according to legal requirements. Proof of this insurance cover has to be satisfactorily shown to the organiser prior to participation.

The undersigned is liable for damages incurred or partly incurred by himself or his vehicle.

For reasons of safety it is absolutely necessary to follow instructions given by the organiser's staff during the event. If an undersigned is offending the code of driving conduct, sport auto is authorised at its own discretion to exclude him from further participating. The enclosed Rules for Spectators from Hockenheim-Ring GmbH must be adhered to. Stepping on the gas pedal when the vehicle is standing on or stuck in the gravel pit or sliding into it, is strictly prohibited. Personal injuries and/or damages to properties due to gravel flying around, for example, impend. You have to wait for the recovery vehicle.

The undersigned takes part in the event at his own risk. As far as legal possibilities are concerned, the undersigned waives any claims against Motor Presse Stuttgart GmbH & Co. KG, its management and employees as well as against any other auxiliary persons in case of property damage or economic loss the undersigned suffers from or in connection with the event. This liability exclusion is also effective in favour of third parties that sport auto makes use of while carrying out the event as well as in favour of the proprietor or otherwise authorised individuals of the premises the event is carried out on.

The undersigned pledges himself to forego damage claims he may possibly be entitled to from Hockenheim-Ring GmbH and possibly further track operating companies and organisers as well as from the sport auto editorial department and its auxiliary persons.

Attention: Fireworks of any type during the sport auto-Tuner GP/sport auto DriftChallenge 2009 require a special permission from the authorities! One week prior to the event at the latest the organiser has to be presented with an official permission from the relevant authorities. Furthermore, the safety measures implemented and the safety staff on site during the fireworks display have to be confirmed in writing. Apart from that, fireworks of any type are strictly prohibited!

Rules for Spectators by Hockenheim-Ring GmbH
at Hockenheimring Baden-Wuerttemberg

Dear visitors to the race,

Welcome to Hockenheim. We wish you a pleasant stay here but at the same time have to call your attention to the following points:

- Every spectator has to have a valid admission ticket that entitles him to access the area stated on the ticket only. If someone enters the premises without a valid admission ticket, it will be reported to the police. If you temporarily leave your seat you have to request a re-admission ticket from the stewards. Only the original admission ticket together with the re-admission ticket entitle you to re-enter the area for spectators. Please show both tickets to the stewards without being asked.
- Lost or stolen tickets will not be replaced. Please watch your tickets carefully.
- Please keep clear of the stairways leading up and down the grandstand. If you need help you also expect that the medical service can reach you without any obstruction.
- Bringing along bulky objects (i.e. cooling bags, beverage crates, glass containers, folding chairs) as well as pyrotechnical devices, weapons and similar items or animals is not permitted.
- Camping or setting up trailers and mobile homes is only permitted in the designated areas. Please park your passenger cars in the designated car parks and let the stewards and police instruct you where exactly to park. Besides, the German road traffic act also applies to Hockenheim.
- Open fire and the displaying of fireworks are strictly prohibited. This highly endangers yourself and other spectators.
- Please follow the instructions from stewards and officials; these individuals add a great deal to the success of the event, also in your interest.
- It is prohibited to enter areas not explicitly open to spectators (i.e. the racetrack, escape routes and restricted areas). Not only do you endanger yourself and other visitors but also make yourself liable to prosecution for trespassing.
- Please help us protect the environment. If you want to dispose of litter please use the waste bins that are provided.
- The admission ticket holder agrees without being remunerated by the organiser to the fact that within the context of the event there will be pictures being made, copied, sent as well as used audio-visually. This agreement is not limited locally and for an indefinite period of time.

As everybody should take pleasure in the motorsports offered at Hockenheimring Baden-Wuerttemberg, we ask you to respect these rules and show understanding for the supervisory staff. We hope you have a nice time and thank you for your attention.
